The A. Les McDonald Award for Innovation & Excellence in Respiratory Care & Education is designed to recognize a healthcare professional who has made an outstanding contribution to respiratory care and education locally and/ or internationally through their practice and/or research.



SELECTION CRITERIA

The nominated individual should meet **two** or more of the following criteria:

- Demonstrated innovation and excellence in the development, delivery and/or provision of respiratory care and education to individuals, families or communities
- Shown a dedication to continued professional growth in the area of respiratory care and education
- Made an outstanding contribution to respiratory care and education through research and/ or publication
- Contributed to the development of the certified respiratory and tobacco educator programs through CNRC volunteerism.

SELECTION PROCEDURES

- A selection committee will independently review all supporting materials and make the final award decision
- The recipient of the award will be announced at CNRC's National Conference on Respiratory Care and Education to be held November 16-18th, 2023 in Vancouver, BC.

Eligibility for Nomination

• Must be a current or retired Certified Asthma, COPD, Respiratory or Tobacco Educator.

Nomination Instructions

To nominate a candidate, you must send a nomination letter which includes the following: **1** Your nominee's name & contact information (*address, telephone & email*)

- **2** Your contact information
- **3** How long you have known the nominee and in what capacity (e.g. recipient of care, colleague etc.)
- **4** An overview of the nominee's achievements in demonstrating innovation and excellence in respiratory care and education

SUBMISSION DEADLINE: FRIDAY, AUGUST 25th, 2023

Nominations received after the deadline will not be considered for the 2023 Award.
